NOMINATION GUIDELINES

The City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder Walk of Fame committee is now calling for nominations for the Kalgoorlie-Boulder Walk of Fame.

During 2017, the Walk of Fame Committee will consider the recognition of at least 1 outstanding Kalgoorlie-Boulder individual with a plaque to be placed on the Eastern end of Hannan Street in the Kalgoorlie CBD.

Recipients will be recognised for their significant and positive contribution to the region of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder and its people.

The 2017 recipient/s will be announced at the 2018 Australia Day Awards Ceremony as part of the Australia Day breakfast.

CRITERIA

1. Nominations are to be received by the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder by close of business Friday 27 October 2017. Late nominations will not be accepted.

2. **NOMINATION FORMS** can be filled in online at the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder website www.ckb.wa.gov.au or a hard copy is available at the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder Administration Building.

3. Unless completing online, all correspondence should be addressed to the Executive Assistant of the Walk of Fame Committee c/o City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder PO Box 2042 Boulder WA 6432.

4. The nominee must have made a significant and positive contribution to the people and the region of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.

5. Nominations are for individuals only, groups are not accepted.

6. The selection committee will have the final decision and no other correspondence will be entered into.

7. Lobbying of the Selection Panel or the Council is not acceptable and may result in the disqualification of the nomination.

8. Nominees must reside or have resided in the region known as the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.

9. Nominations are retained and reviewed in each award year thereafter.

CITY OF KALGOORLIE-BOULDER AUSTRALIA DAY AWARDS

Guidelines

Each year a local citizen/s and one local community group in the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder will be eligible for the Australia Day Awards.

The recipients will be selected from people and groups who have made a noteworthy contribution during the current year, or given outstanding service to the local community over a number of years through active involvement.

The City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder Australia Day Awards provides awards each year for presentation at the "Big Aussie Breakfast" on Australia Day.

Nomination Process

The City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder invites nominations for the awards from community groups and private citizens.

Selection Criteria

The winners will be judged on their active citizenship and:

- Significant contribution to the local community.
- Demonstrated leadership on a community issue relating to the enhancement of community life.
- A significant initiative which has brought about a positive change and added value to community life.
- Inspiring qualities as a role model for the community.

Eligibility

- Nominees should reside or work principally within the locality of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.
- Awards may be granted posthumously in recognition of recent achievements.
- Groups of people or couples will not normally be eligible except when meeting the criteria for a community group.
- A person cannot receive the same award twice, but can be considered for another award.
- Unsuccessful nominees may be nominated in future years.
- Sitting members of State, Federal and Local Government are not eligible for nomination for work undertaken in their official capacity.

Judging Process

All category winners of the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder Australia Day Awards will be selected from nominations received from the community. The judging panel will be made up of representatives from the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.

These prestigious awards are only available to one recipient in each category in each year. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into by the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder.

The City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder reserves the right to redefine categories to accommodate outstanding nominations.

Presentation of Awards

Awards will be presented at the "Big Aussie Breakfast" on Australia Day, 26 January 2018 at Centennial Park.
